1	<p>Environment subgroup:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Help to identify what to spend Clean & Green Environment budget for the area £1500 and £2,600 Environment Budget. - Consider how we could improve local parks and open spaces. - Help to improve the way our roads are cleansed and the area is kept tidy. - Monitor the progress of the relevant section of the Neighbourhood Partnership Plan priorities.
2	<p>Wellbeing Budget: £17,400 per year.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Get involved in helping to allocate local grants to improve the area. - Be part of an advisory group to help assess applications from community groups operating in the area.
3	<p>Traffic & Transport</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Monitor the progress of the relevant section of the Neighbourhood Partnership Plan priorities. - Help identify local traffic and transport issues and how to overcome them. - Help to prioritise annual Highways and Minor Traffic works for the area. - Get involved in shaping Highways services in our neighbourhood.
4	<p>Operation subgroup</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Monitor the progress of the relevant section of the Neighbourhood Partnership Plan priorities. - Participate in forward planning for the Partnerships activities. - Help develop any other initiatives or procedures that will help to develop & ensure the smooth running of the Neighbourhood Partnership.
5	<p>Communication subgroup</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Monitor the progress of the relevant section of the Neighbourhood Partnership Plan priorities. - To improve and encourage public knowledge, support and engagement with the -Neighbourhood Partnership and its meetings and work. - Help set-up NF agenda.

6	<p>Neighbourhood Forum (NF)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This is an open public forum for local community members to participate and find out what is happening in their neighbourhood. Community members can come to raise issues, find out what is happening in their neighbourhood or simply come to meet and network with other local community activist and volunteers.
7	<p>Neighbourhood Partnership (NP)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This is the management body of the Neighbourhood Partnership. The meetings are formal and it is where recommendations from subgroups are considered and decisions are taken by relevant members.
